SUBSIDISED TAXI TRAVEL

What is Subsidised Taxi Travel?

Community Transport: Wollongong-Shellharbour provides subsidised taxi travel. Eligible people receive an allocated number of Taxi E-Tickets to assist them with meeting their transport needs. Community Transport Services, including Taxi E-Tickets are funded under the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) and the Community Transport Program (CTP). They assist older people who are transport disadvantaged and their carers to maintain their independence and quality of life.

Who is Eligible?

Older people, their carers and people who are transport disadvantaged and their carers who:

- are 65 Years or older, or 50 Years or older for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- referred to the Service by My Aged Care and meet the service's eligibility criteria
- reside in the Illawarra Area (Austinmer to Dunmore)
- live independently within the community
- be unable to use public transport safely and independently
- cannot drive independently at the present time
- are transport disadvantaged, and whose access to mainstream transport services is limited by physical, social or geographical factors.
- Are not receiving Taxi Transport Subsidy Scheme (TTSS) docketts.

What can Taxi E-Tickets be used for?

Taxi E-Tickets can be used at any time for essential transport including:

- Medical appointments
- Shopping and bill paying
- Hospital or nursing home visits
- Social outings

How to apply for Taxi E-Tickets?

If you are 65 years old or over or an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander 50 years or over, please call My Aged Care on 1800 200 422 for an assessment.

If you do not meet the above criteria and are transport disadvantaged, please call the office for an individual assessment on 1300 987 422.

If you are eligible to receive [Taxi E-Tickets](#), information including a 'Taxi E-Ticket Order Form' will be sent to you. From here you will need to:

Step 1 Complete and sign the 'E-Ticket Order Form'

Step 2 Forward the 'E-Ticket Order Form' along with payment to:

OR

Make a payment in person at the cashiers located on the ground floor of Wollongong City Council, 41 Burelli Street, Wollongong.

Only one allocation per household will be provided.

How often can I get Taxi E-Tickets?

You are able to apply for E-Tickets every three months, as long as a reasonable number of the previously issued E-Tickets have been used.

The E-Tickets have an expiry date of approximately 12 months; this is printed on the E-Ticket itself.

Cost

An allocation of E-Tickets valued at \$150 is available for a cost of \$30, payable by cheque/ money order through the post, or cash/card at the Wollongong City Council Cashiers.

E-Ticket allocations are available in two denominations:

- 10 x \$15 E-Tickets
- 15 x \$10 E-Tickets

Clients cannot have a combination of E-Ticket denominations, however you can change the value of the E-Tickets on your next allocation.

How to use the Taxi E-Tickets?

Taxi bookings can be made directly through Illawarra Taxi Network on 131 008 or (02) 4254 2111.

Please advise the Illawarra Taxi Network at the time of booking or the taxi driver when flagging a taxi, if you are planning to use the E-Tickets.

E-Tickets can be used in conjunction with cash but change will not be provided.

For example:

You undertake a taxi trip which costs \$11. You may choose to pay the driver 1 x \$10 E-Tickets and a \$1 coin.

If the trip costs \$14 and you choose to give the driver 1 x \$15 E-Tickets there will be no change given.

The E-Tickets cannot be used in conjunction with Taxi Transport Subsidy Scheme (TTSS) docketts or any other type of vouchers.

Only one E-Ticket can be used per taxi trip.
